## Team Leader Instructions

*Our 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Bowl-a-Thon is a fun way for ARCA to partner with the community to increase awareness and raise funds in support of over 600 individuals with developmental disabilities.*

### Recruit Bowlers

ARCA is inviting 48 teams of bowlers, consisting of a team leader, 2-3 recruited bowlers and 1 or 2 individuals receiving services from ARCA (5 total team members) to participate in our 2010 Bowl-a-Thon. People may join an existing team or volunteer to be a team leader and form their own. **Team leaders should keep in mind that each bowler should collect a minimum of ten pledges.** Try to pick team members you know will get out there and get pledges from sponsors such as family, neighbors, friends and/or co-workers. Individuals receiving services from ARCA are encouraged to be a part of this process! ### Get Pledges

There is no fee to bowl, rent equipment or enjoy food and beverages! The only requirement to participate is a minimum of ten pledges per player. Team leaders should encourage bowlers to collect as many pledges as possible - \$1000 per team is our goal! Using the pledge sheet provided, bowlers can approach family, friends, neighbors and/or coworkers to ask them to make a pledge.

### There are two kinds of pledges.

- Per pin pledges are based on the score the bowler achieves. The minimum suggested per pin pledge is \$0.25. For example, if a sponsor pledges 25 cents per pin and the bowler gets a score of 140, the sponsor's donation will be \$35 (.25 cents times 140). **Note: the minimum score will be 100.**
- Sponsors may also choose to make a flat rate pledge. The advantage of a flat rate pledge is that the bowler does not need to collect money after they bowl. They can collect the donation while getting sponsors. The minimum suggested flat rate pledge is \$50.
- Of course, a sponsor may choose to do both!

Instruct bowlers to have sponsors make checks payable to the ARCA Foundation.

### Bowl

**This is the fun part!** Team leaders ensure that each team member who has collected pledges bowls at least one game. That's right - hundreds of people bowling and having a blast getting to know each other!

### Collect Pledges

Afterwards, team leaders should instruct bowlers to enter the final score on their pledge sheets and collect the appropriate amount from *Per Pin Sponsors*. **All money received should be submitted to the ARCA Foundation no later than Friday, June 11.** For cash donations, ask if a receipt is desired. If so, note on the pledge form and inform the sponsor the ARCA Foundation will provide a receipt. All checks should be made payable to the ARCA Foundation.

### Send Money to ARCA

It will be up to the team leader to insure all donations are collected and submitted to ARCA. Team leaders may instruct the bowlers to send checks and pledge sheets directly to ARCA. Please indicate your team name on all checks.
